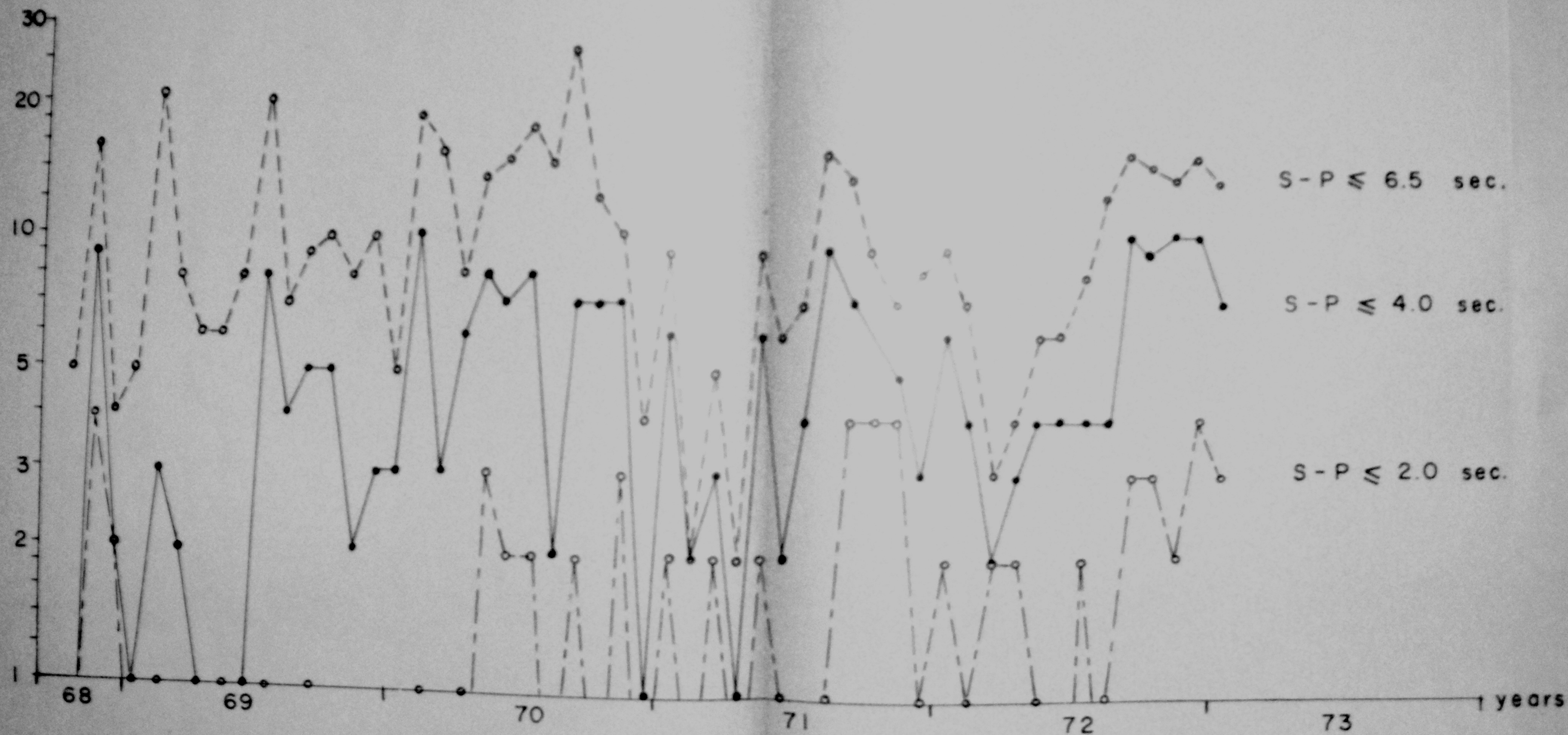

the latitudinal plane

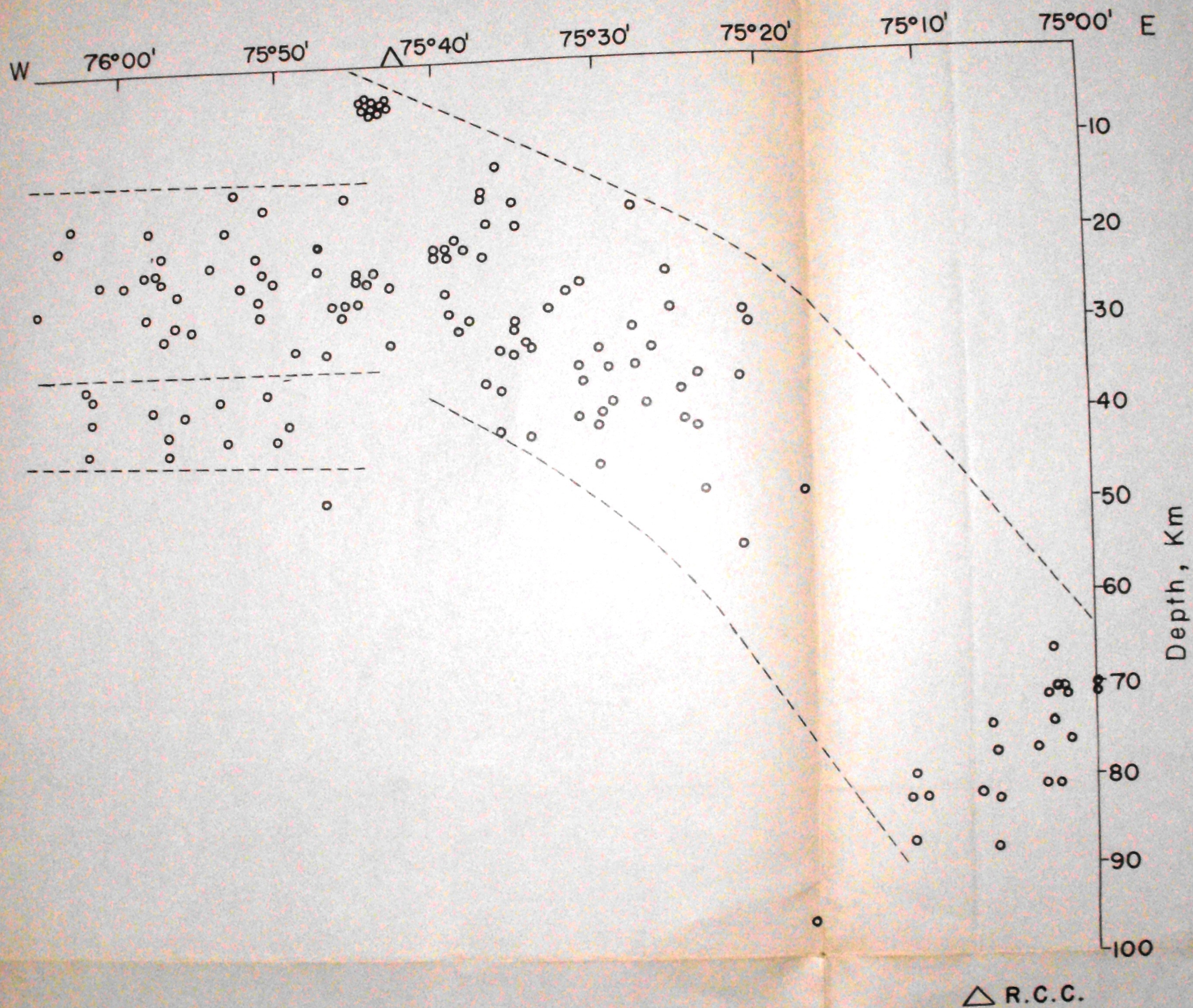

cal section of the longitudinal plane._

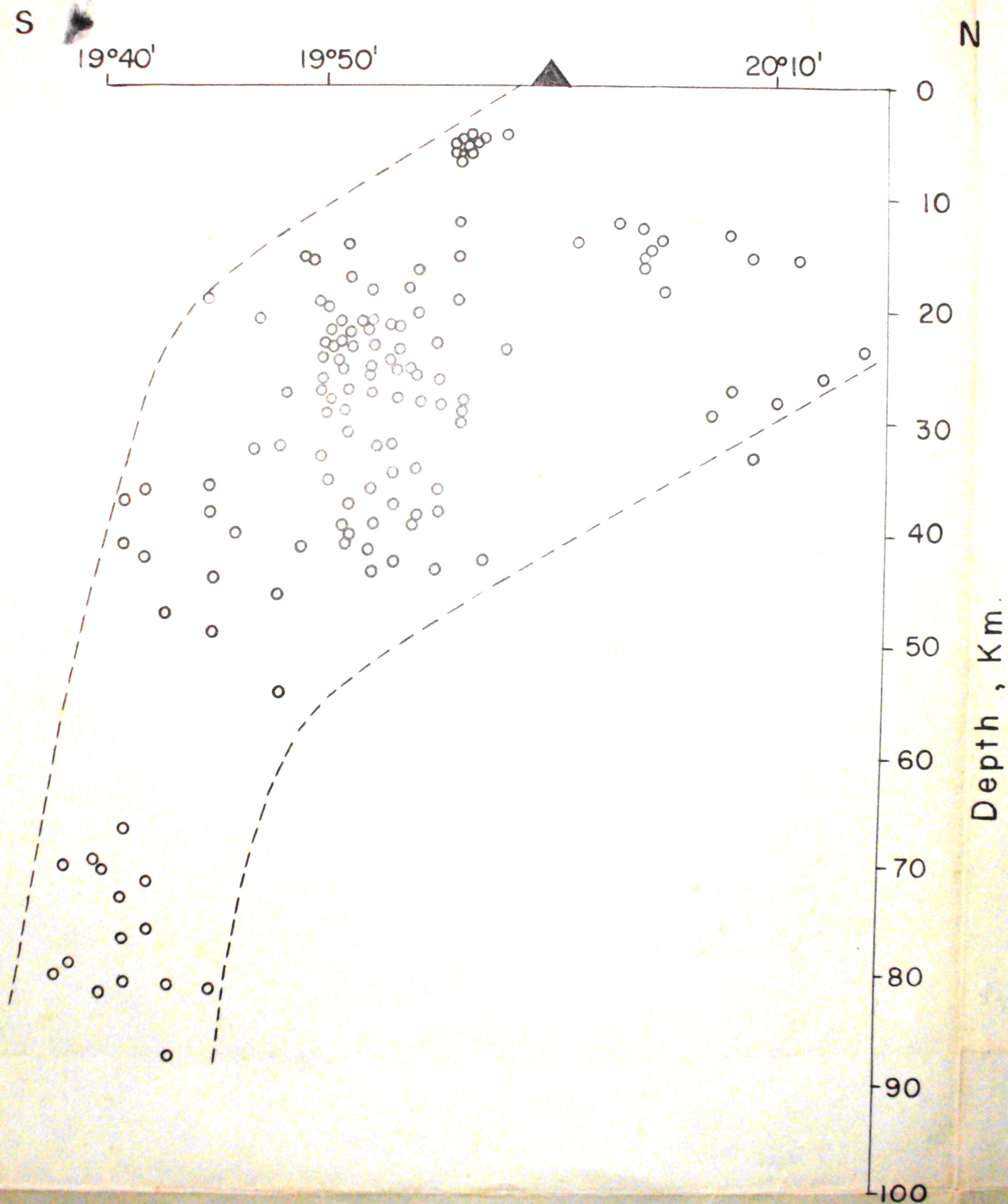












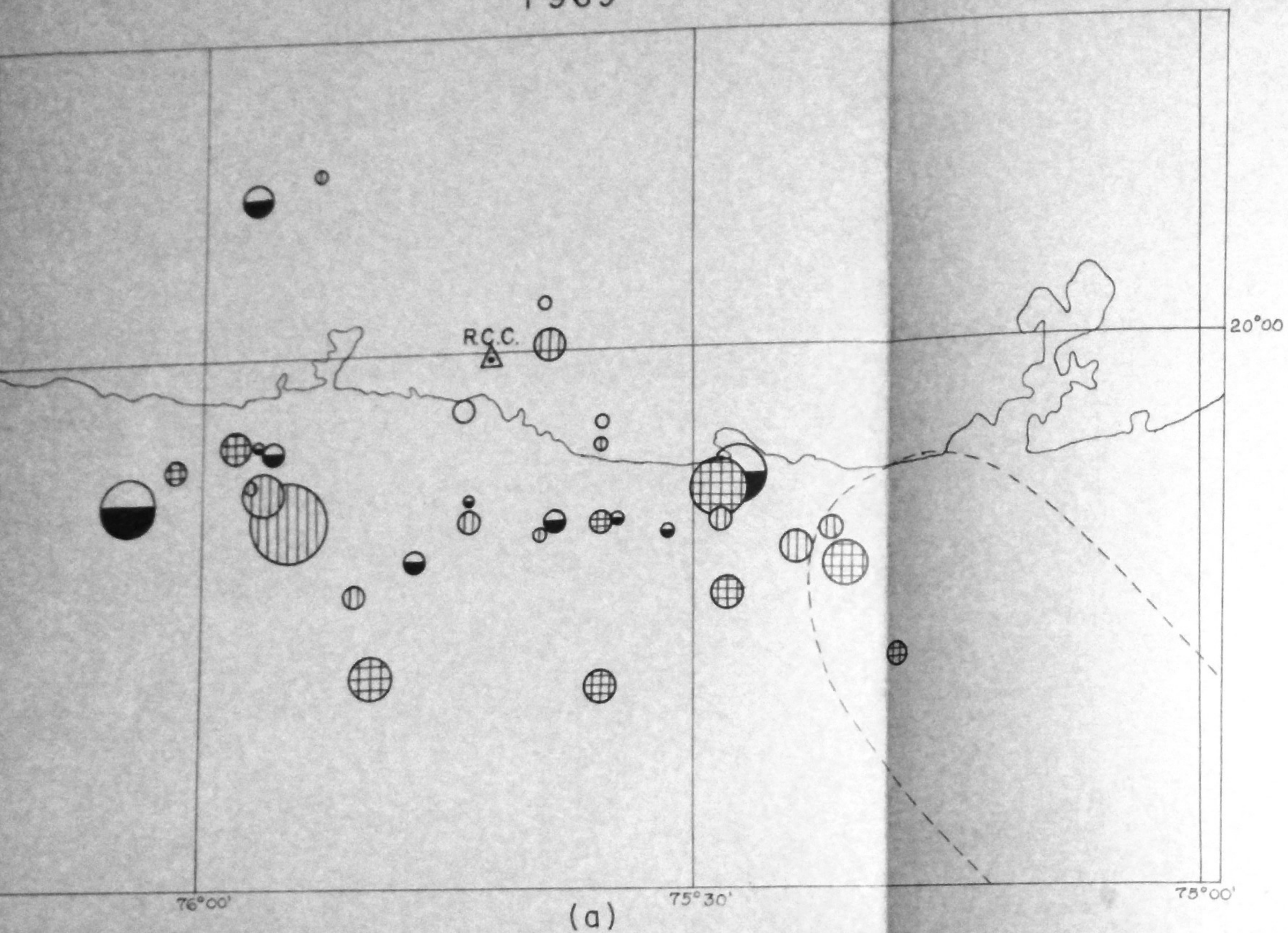

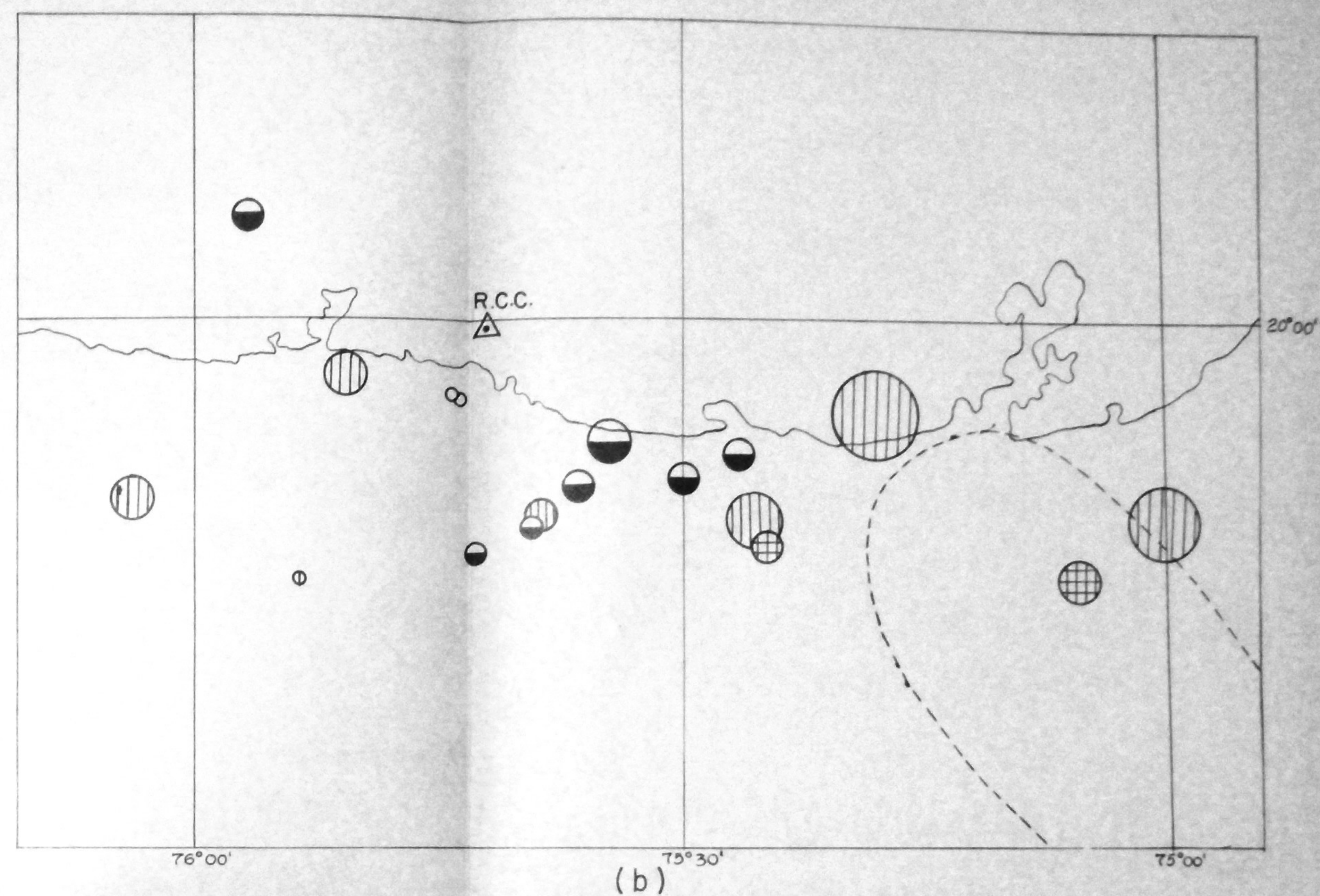

SPACE DISTRIBUTION OF EARTHQUAKES IN ANNUAL TIME INTERVALS

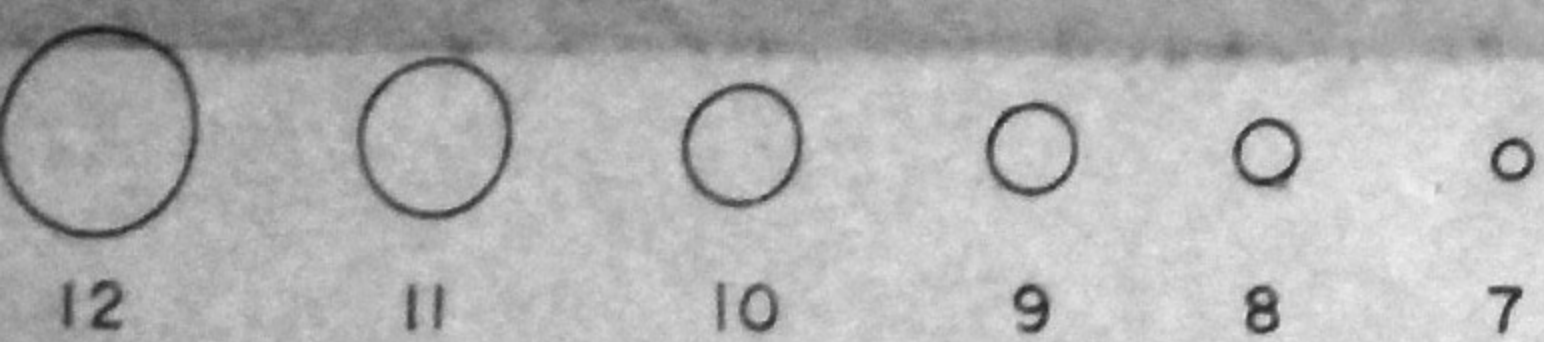

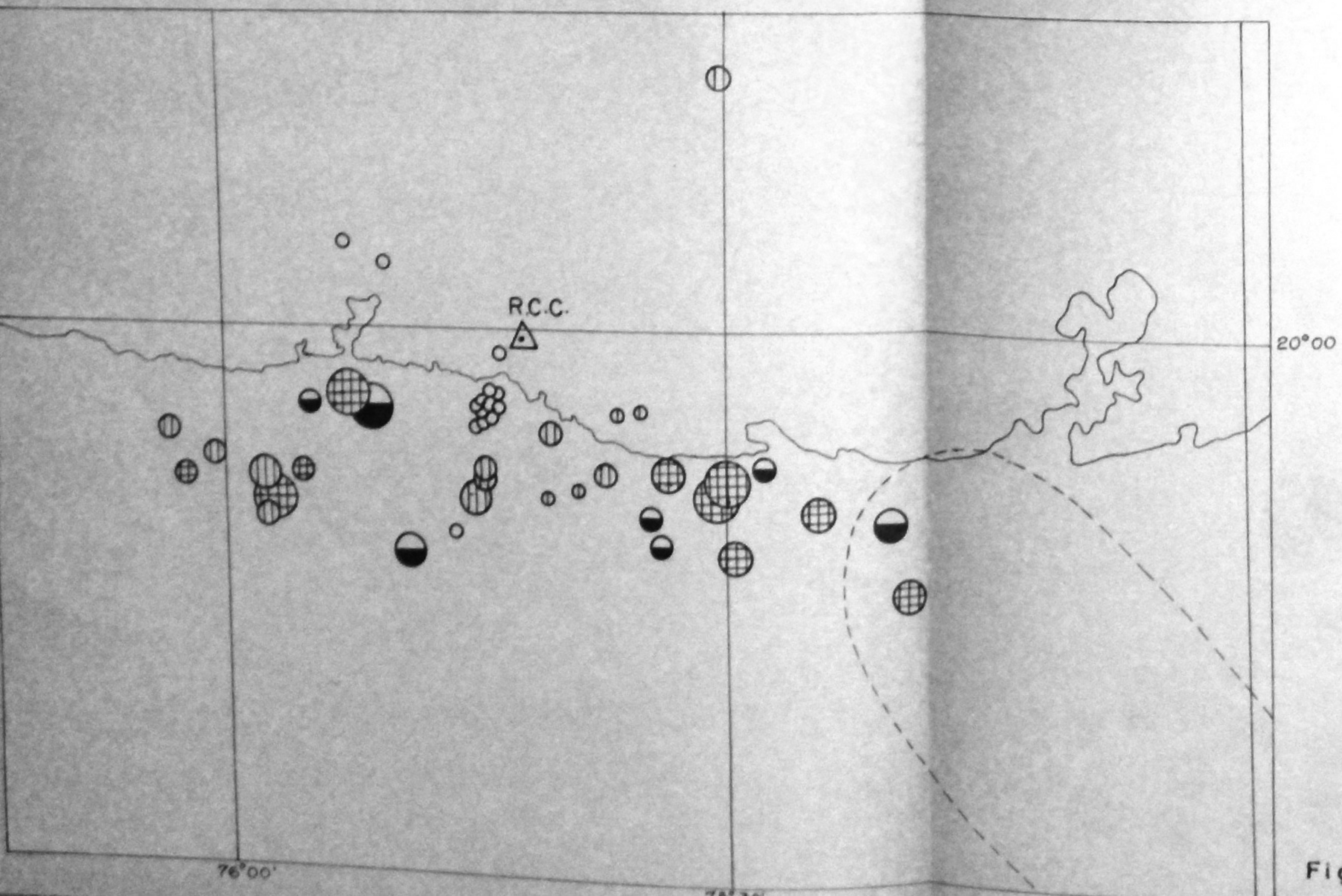

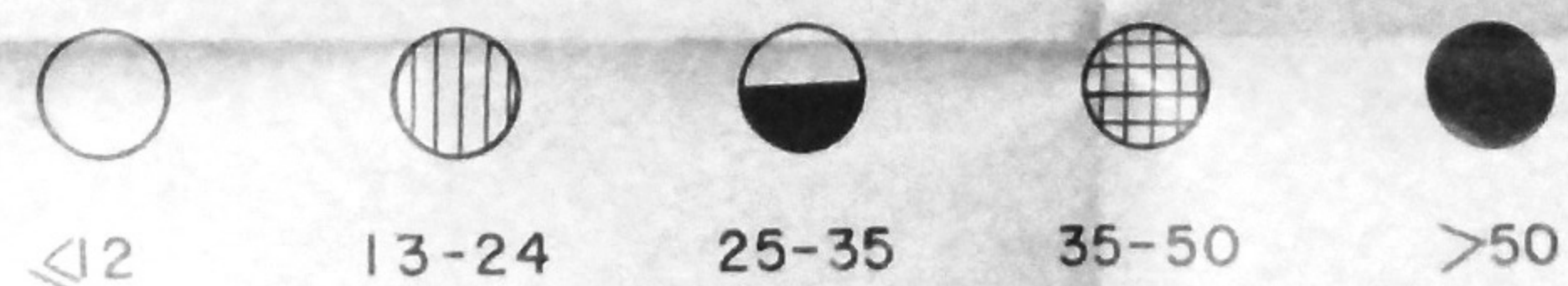
Energy index, K

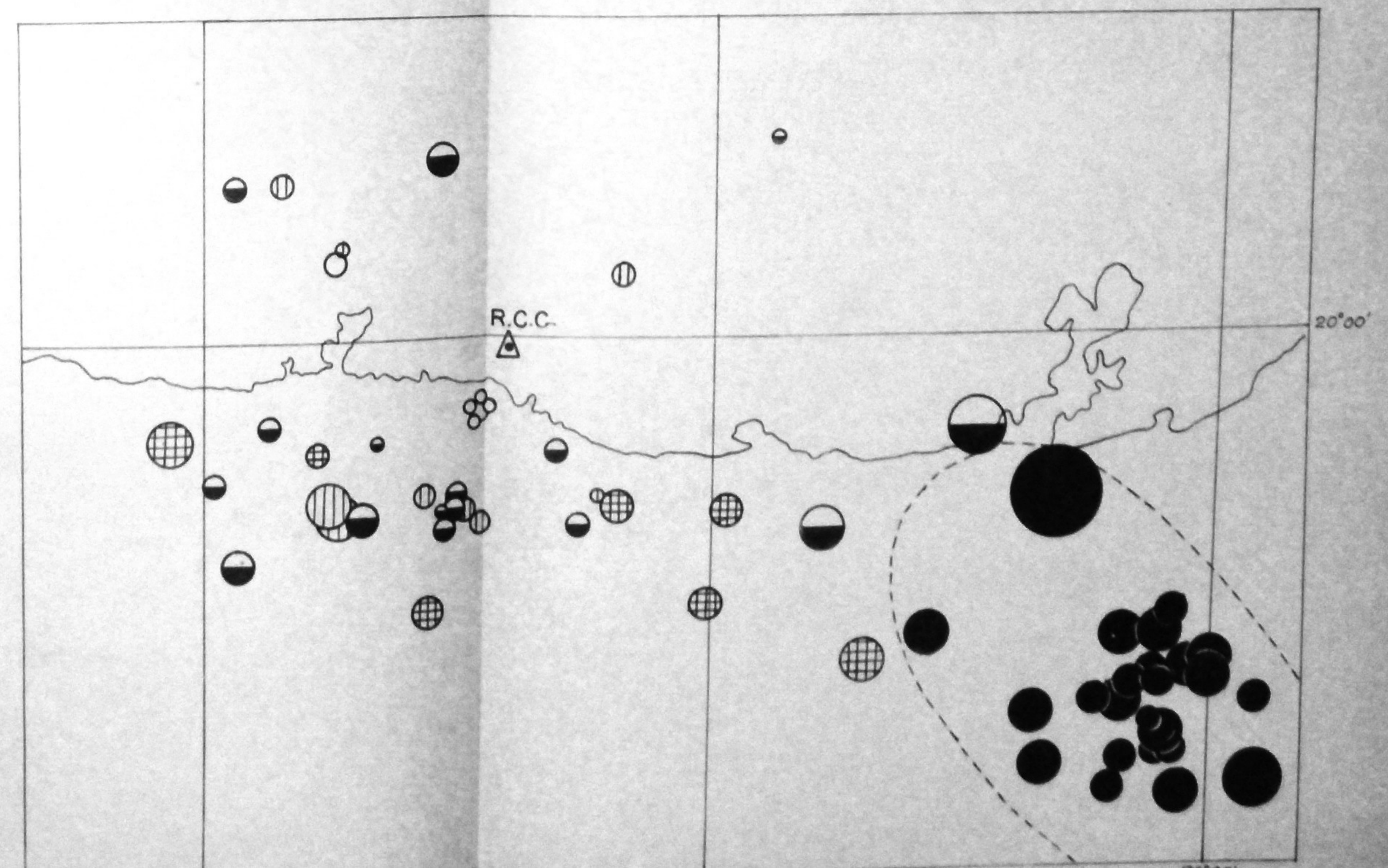
